



Step-by-Step Hair Styles Peacock Twist

NOTE: Please read the “Four Quick Steps to Getting Started” section BEFORE you begin to understand how to hold the comb, etc.

Step 1

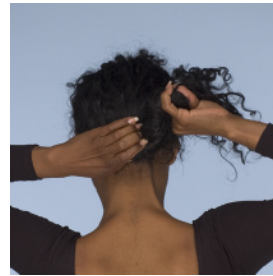


Gather hair into a ponytail. **FIRMLY TWIST** the ponytail from the base/nape of your neck straight up, maintaining an even tension the entire length.

NOTE: The longer your hair, the LOWER on the back of your head you should start twisting your hair. Otherwise, the ends will be too long for the “spray”.



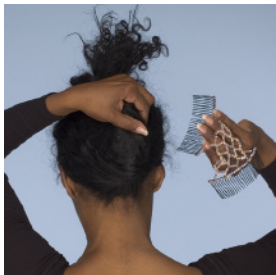
Step 2



Continue twisting upward until you are just below the top of your head and until only a few inches remain loose on top for your “spray”.



Step 3

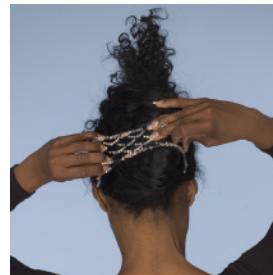


Hold first comb in right hand (Read 4 Quick and Easy Steps for images of hand placement).

SLIDE first comb into hair along scalp. Tips of comb teeth should not be completely underneath the twist, and should rest more on the right side.



Step 4



REACH through stretch bands with the fingers of right hand to hold hair in place.

STRETCH the second comb with left hand as far as possible before **FLIPPING** it under and **SLIDING / HIDING** it back into the hair.



Finished!



Reach up and adjust the hair until you are pleased with the “Peacock Fan Tail” on top.



Styling Hints:

For sleek hair, try dampening your hair slightly for this style. It will make your ponytail easier to twist.

For short hair: Begin your twist higher—in the center of your head—or you will run out of hair before you reach the top.
