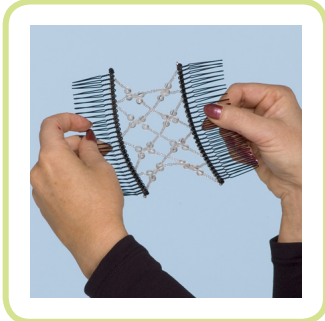




## HairZing 101 Just a Tug...Holds Snug



The principle behind the combs and stretch-bands is they work together to form a “locking hold.” When the combs are stretched apart, they hold in place because the bands maintain tension between them.

### To Tighten:



Stretch the combs wide apart—even ear to ear. The farther you stretch, the tighter the grip.

Hold the first comb in place so it won't slip, and s-t-r-e-t-c-h the second comb to the other side.

### To Loosen:



Gently reach up and push the combs together, towards the center of the head. The grip immediately loosens.

Stop when you find the most comfortable fit.

### If the combs feel like they are slipping or too loose:

- Butterfly Twist in the center to tighten
- Stretch the combs farther apart when you are putting into your hair.
- Move combs UP onto wider curve of the head (as opposed to nape of neck)
